ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

- 1. Remove all packaging materials, staples and packing straps from the carton.
- 2. Refer to Parts List and Hardware List and ensure they are complete before you start assembling.
- Place all wooden parts on a clean, flat and soft surface (e.g. carpet or rug) to prevent parts from getting scratched.

Step 1. First, place Leg Base Board (P3) bottom-side up. Next, align holes on Foot Block (P4) to holes on Leg Base Board (P3). Then insert JCBC Screw (H2) fitted with Spring Washer (H3) into each of the 2 holes. Use Allen Key (HI) to tighten (H2). Do not tighten (H2) completely until both screws are in place. Do not over tighten the screws.



Step 2. Place Pedestal Leg (P2) bottom-side up. Align the 4 holes at the central part of Leg Base Board (P3) to holes on Pedestal Leg (P2). Then insert JCBC Screw (H2) fitted with Spring Washer (H3) into the holes. Use Allen Key (H1) to tighten (H2). Do not tighten (H2) completely until all 4 screws are in place. Do not over tighten the screws.



Step 3. Place Pedestal Leg (P2) standing up as shown. Align the 4 innermost holes on Mounting Bar (P5) to the 4 holes on Pedestal Leg (P2). Then insert JCBC Screw (H2) fitted with Spring Washer (H3) into the holes. Use Allen Key (H1) to tighten (H2). Do not tighten (H2) completely until all 4 screws are in place. Do not over tighten the screws.



Step 4. Place Table Top (P1) bottom-side up on a material that does not scratch or damage the part. Align holes on Mounting Bar (P5) to holes on table bottom. Insert JCBC Screw (H2) fitted with Spring Washer (H3) into the holes. Use Allen Key (H1) to tighten (H2). Do not tighten (H2) completely until all 4 screws are in place. Do not over tighten the screws. Insert Adjustable Leg Glide (H4) to the Foot Block holes, and use hand to screw in (H4) completely. Do not over tighten. Turn the table right-side up. The assembly of the table is complete.

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- a) Lay the 1-piece Backrest & Seat (A) bottom-side up as shown on a material that does not scratch or damage the part.
- b) Place Back Leg (B) to align screw holes on (B) to screw holes on corner block at the rear corners of (A).
- c) Fasten Leg to corner block using Screw (E), Spring Washer (G) and Flat Washer (F). Use Allen Key (H) to drive screw. Do not tighten screws completely until both screws are in place on each leg.



Use the same procedures in STEP 1 to attach and fasten Front Legs (C).



- STEP 3 Balance check Refer to Drawing #3.
- a) Place chair upright on a flat, level surface.
- b) Check that the chair is level.
- c) Check all of the screws and re-tighten as necessary. Do not over-tighten the screws.
