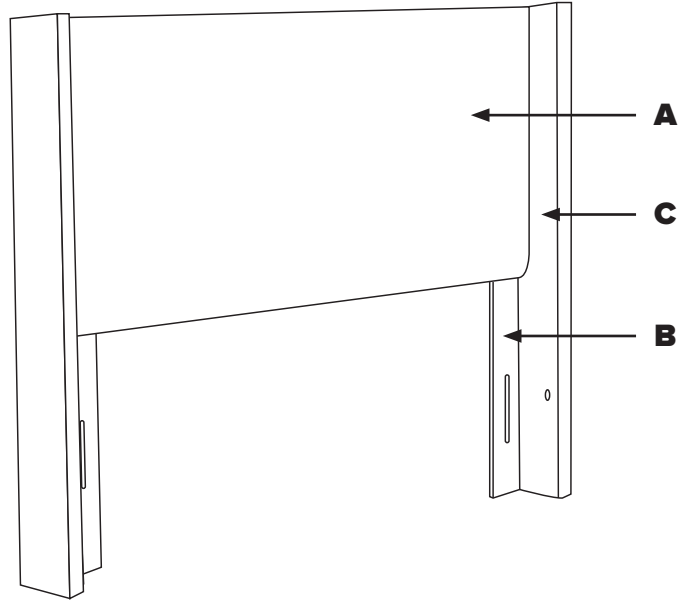


WINGBACK HEADBOARD ASSEMBLY

COMPONENTS

ITEM	DESCRIPTION	QTY
A	Headboard	1
B	Headboard Leg	2
C	Wing	2

Please note: actual headboard may look different than illustration.



HARDWARE



(H1) x 8
2" x 5/16" bolt



(H2) x 26
1 1/4" washer



(H3) x 4
5/8" x 5/16" bolt



(H4) x 4
1 x 1/4" bolt



(H5) x 4
1/4" nuts

Please note: you will need a flat head screwdriver and a wrench to assemble your headboard.

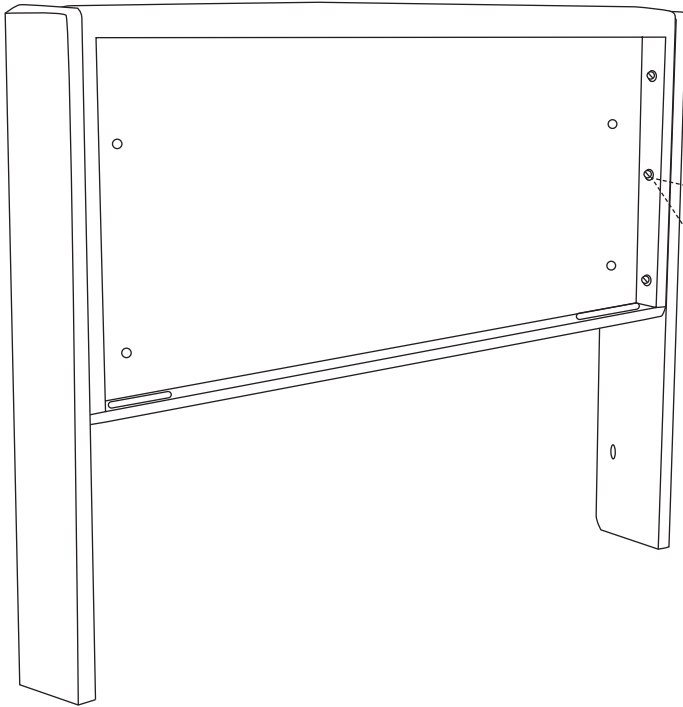
LIMITED WARRANTY

WINGBACK HEADBOARD ASSEMBLY

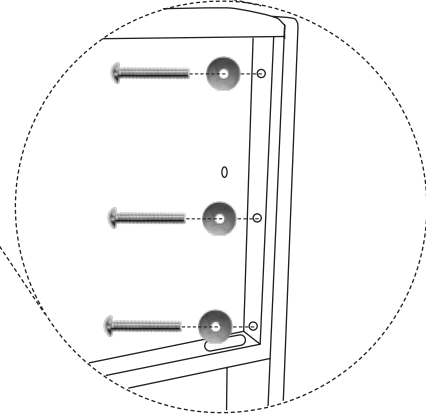
STEP 1 - ATTACHING THE WINGS



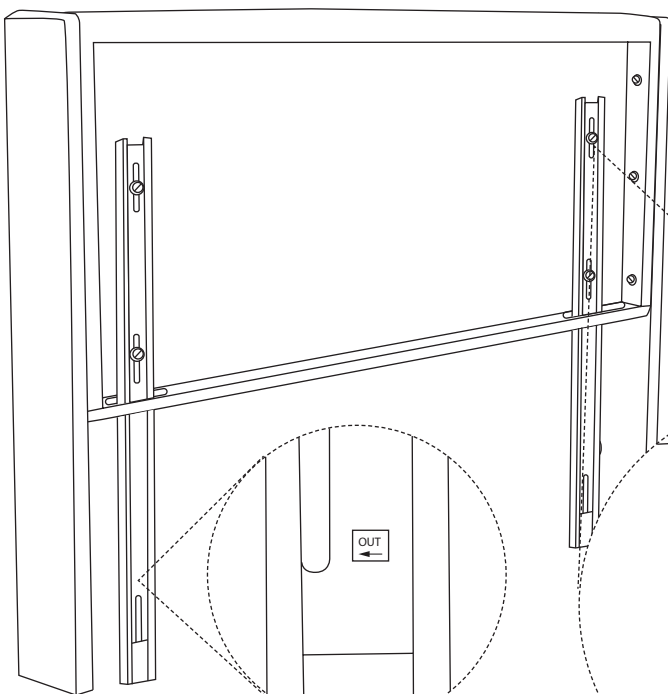
1.1

Attach (C) wing to (A) headboard using (H1) bolts and (H2) washer. Tighten using flat head screwdriver.

Please note: Make sure the top of the (A) headboard is level with the top of the (C) wings before tightening.



STEP 2 - ATTACHING THE HEADBOARD LEGS

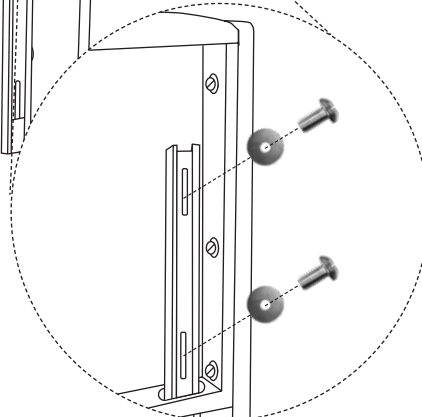
Insert (B) headboard leg through hole of (A) headboard and align the slots with the holes.

Please note: Make sure the "Out" sticker on each (B) headboard leg is facing the correct way.

2.2

Attach (B) headboard legs to (A) headboard using (H3) bolts and (H2) washers. Tighten with a flat head screwdriver.

Please note: Make sure the (B) headboard legs are flush with the ground before tightening.

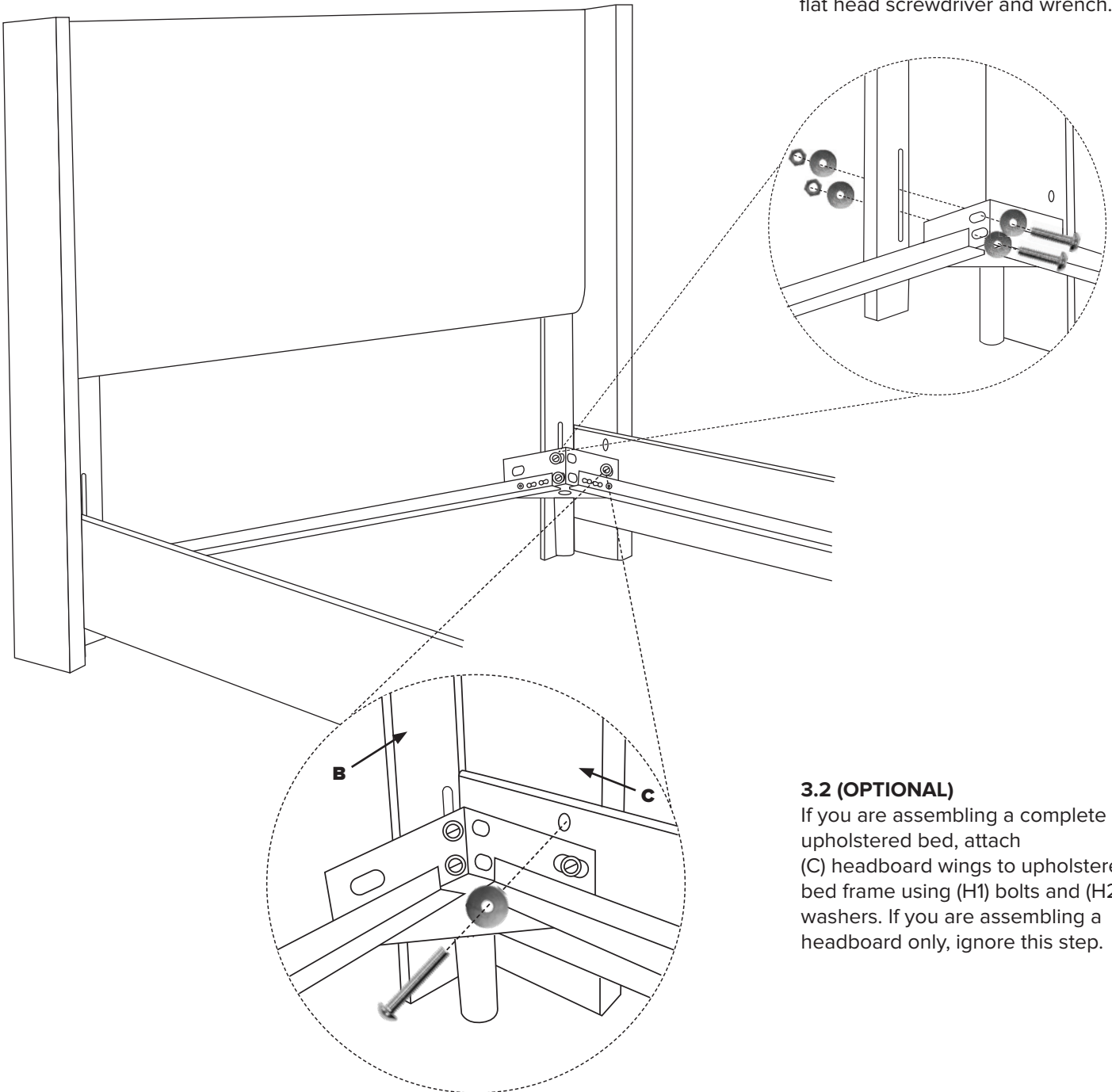


WINGBACK HEADBOARD ASSEMBLY

STEP 3 - ATTACHING ASSEMBLED HEADBOARD TO BED FRAME

3.1

Attach assembled headboard to your bed frame using (H4) bolts, (H2) washers and (H5) nuts. Tighten with a flat head screwdriver and wrench.



3.2 (OPTIONAL)

If you are assembling a complete upholstered bed, attach (C) headboard wings to upholstered bed frame using (H1) bolts and (H2) washers. If you are assembling a headboard only, ignore this step.
