

Leather Care Tips



Try to maintain at least 2 feet between your furniture & heating sources.



Avoid placing your furniture in direct sunlight. All materials will fade over time when placed in direct sunlight. ANILINE leathers are especially sensitive to sunlight.



With leather, you can fully remove dust particles from the surface with the Leather Master Soft Cleaner making it ideal for dust sensitive people. Apply Leather Master Protection Cream to the leather's surface to help resist staining and prevent overall soiling.



Fully clean your furniture with the Soft Cleaner and re-protect with the Protection Cream every six months to remove dirt as well as the gradual accumulation of body oils and perspiration. For oil based stains, use the Leather Master Degreaser.



Do not use any other products that are not recommended by the manufacturer as they may negatively affect the leather's surface.
