

We inspect all wood and follow quality assurance guidelines that pass third-party inspections.

Note: Real wood has knots, small cracks, and what may look like blemishes. These characteristics are expected when producing furniture from natural material.

We take extra care with our drawer parts:

- 1. We use real wood drawer sides and drawer backs.
- 2. Drawer sides and backs are not finished to protect fabrics from any residual paint odor.
- Drawer parts are finely sanded to prevent snags.



Carpet creates too much bounce making assembly difficult and could lead to damage of the parts.




DO NOT FORCE OR **OVER-TIGHTEN THE** SCREWS. DOING SO CAN DAMAGE THE PARTS.




Safety and Care Advice

- · Check that you have all the components and tools listed on pages 3 & 4.
- · Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- · Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- · Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- · Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- · Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- · Opened box can be used to protect your floor or counter during assembly.
- · Assembly is easier for drawer parts on a counter.
- · Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- · We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws, as overtightening could damage the unit.
- · Only use hand screwdrivers.
- · Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly. Please recycle the box. Go green
- · Never sit, stand or allow children to climb on the assembled unit.






INSERT DOWELS INTO THE PARTS. AS SHOWN.






1. WITH THE WHEEL END OF THE RUNNER TOWARD THE FRONT (FINISHED) EDGE OF THE PANEL, ALIGN THE PRE-DRILLED HOLE IN THE PANEL WITH THE SECOND HOLE BACK FROM THE WHEEL.


2. LOOSELY SECURE THE FRONT END OF THE RUNNER USING THE PART B SCREW.





- "CL" Front
- 3. ALIGN THE RUNNER SO THE REMAINING 2 PRE-DRILLED HOLES IN THE PANEL ARE VISIBLE THROUGH THE HOLES IN THE RUNNER.
- 4. LOOSELY SECURE THE 2ND & 3RD SCREWS.
- 5. RETURN TO THE 1ST SCREW & TIGHTEN. THEN TIGHTEN 2ND & 3RD SCREWS.
- 6. REPEAT FOR EACH RUNNER AND THE OTHER PANEL.




E = 4 (Left side) D = 4 (Right side) Cabinet Left "CL" Cabinet Right Runner "CR" Runner









ASSEMBLE THE DRAWER BOX 4X




1. ALIGN THE DOWELS IN THE DRAWER SIDES WITH THE PRE-DRILLED HOLES IN THE DRAWER FRONT AND PUSH UNTIL THE PARTS ARE FLUSH.


IMPORTANT! MAKE SURE THE GROOVES IN THE DRAWER FRONT AND BOTH SIDES ALL ALIGN BEFORE TIGHTENING THE SCREWS.




2. USE THE DRAWER BACK TO SUPPORT THE DRAWER SIDES. THEN SECURE THEM TO THE DRAWER FRONT.




3. REMOVE THE DRAWER BACK.



4. SLIDE IN THE DRAWER BOTTOM. MAKE SURE IT IS ALL THE WAY FORWARD & IN THE GROOVE ON THE DRAWER FRONT.



5. MAKE SURE THE DRAWER BOTTOM IS IN THE GROOVE IN THE DRAWER BACK AND THE DRAWER BACK IS FLUSH WITH THE DRAWER SIDES. SECURE WITH 2 PART C SCREWS ON EACH SIDE.




6. ATTACH THE KNOB TO THE DRAWER FRONT.












- 3. SECOND SCREW GOES IN THE FIFTH BACK HOLE FROM THE DRAWER FRONT.
- **4.** THIRD SCREW GOES IN FROM THE SIDE THROUGH THE FIRST HOLE IN FRONT OF THE WHEEL.
- **5.** REPEAT THE PROCESS ON THE LEFT SIDE AND FOR EACH DRAWER.

TIP: To make this step easier, place the drawer upside down on a counter with the drawer front hanging off the edge. This will allow the drawer box to lay flat and provide better control for tightening the screws.




Drawer Right "DR" Runner

E = 4 (Left side)




Drawer Left "DL" Runner



SECURE THE UNIT TO THE WALL WITH THE ANTI-TIP KIT

- 1. INSERT THE ANCHOR INTO THE WALL APPROXIMATELY 992 MM (39 IN) FROM THE FLOOR (ADJUST FOR CARPET OR RUG THICKNESS IF APPLICABLE).
- 2. FEED PART C SCREW THROUGH THE SMALLER HOLE IN THE BRACKET AND SECURE INTO THE WALL ANCHOR. THE OTHER END OF THE BRACKET SHOULD BE UPWARD.
- 3. FEED PART I SCREW THROUGH THE SMALLER HOLE IN THE OTHER BRACKET AND SECURE THROUGH THE BACK PANEL AND INTO THE CENTER OF THE TOP PANEL. THE OTHER END OF THE BRACKET SHOULD BE UPWARD.
- 4. FEED THE STRAP THROUGH THE LARGER HOLE IN THE WALL BRACKET FROM UNDERNEATH. BRING THE STRAP OVER TO THE UNIT BRACKET AND THROUGH THE HOLE FROM ABOVE.
- 5. INSERT THE POINTED END OF THE STRAP INTO THE CLASP END OF THE STRAP AND TIGHTEN DOWN.

SEE THE ENLARGED DIAGRAMS TO ENSURE PROPER INSTALLATION.











CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

- WHEN NEEDED TO CLEAN SCUFFS:WIPE CLEAN WITH A SLIGHTLY DAMP CLOTH AND A MILD CLEANSER. THEN WIPE DRY WITH A CLEAN CLOTH. DO NOT USE HARSH CHEMICALS.
