

## INSTALL WALL ANCHORS

- The ADJUSTABLE SHOWER BAR works best if secured to a wall stud or cross brace within the wall, using the SCREWS supplied.
- If the ADJUSTABLE SHOWER BAR is to be installed on a tile or plaster wall the ANCHORS (1) and SCREWS (2) should be used.
- Determine desired height and location (optional) and mark the top center line. Use a level to help mark the vertical center line for the two mounting locations. The distance between the two mounting holes is 30" (765 mm).
- *Note: This dimension is important and must be maintained.* If ESCUTCHEON is secured to a stud or cross brace with in the wall, drill small pilot holes for SCREWS (2).
- For installations on drywall or tiled walls: Use ANCHORS (1) and SCREWS (2) for securing ESCUTCHEON to finished wall.
- Drill two 1/4" (6 mm) dia. holes a minimum of 1-3/4" (44 mm) deep. Insert the two ANCHORS (1) flush with face of the finished wall.



## 2 INSTALL ADJUSTABLE SHOWER BAR

- Remove CAP (1) from SHOWER RAIL (2).
- Secure SHOWER RAIL (2) to the wall using MOUNTING SCREWS (3). Do not fully tighten. After alignment is made, tighten the MOUNTING SCREWS (3) fully.
- Instal CAP (1) back onto SHOWER RAIL (2).



## **3** INSTALL WALL SUPPLY

- Supply to WALL SUPPLY is 1/2" NPT. See rough-in above for detailed information.
- Apply sealant or sealing tape to threads of 1/2" NPT supply nipple.



## 4 INSTALL HOSE AND HAND SHOWER

- Remove HAND SHOWER (1) from the hose. Turn water supplies on to flush water lines thoroughly.
- Turn handles "off" and replace HAND SHOWER (1).
- Use KNOB (3) on HOLDER (2) to adjust HAND SHOWER (1) height on slide bar.
