Re: Material Safety Data Sheet for Container Products (Corrugated Packaging Products, All Types and Styles All North American Plants of Manufacture)

## Dear

You requested a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) for our packaging products shipped to Manufacturing. The OSHA Hazard Communication Standard, 29 CFR 1910.1200, is intended to ensure that the hazards of all "hazardous chemicals" be identified and that this information, along with information on protective measures, be passed along to users in the manufacturing sector and their employees.

OSHA realized that requests would be made for MSDSs on materials not readily classified as "hazardous chemicals." The products you inquire about are considered to be articles by OSHA's definition in paragraph (c) of the hazard communication standard:

The article states a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle:

- 1. which is formed to specific shape or design during manufacture;
- 2. which has end-use function (s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use:
- 3. which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, e.g. minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical (as determined under paragraph (d) of this section (of the hazard communication standard) and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees.

The packaging products will not release hazardous chemicals under normal conditions of use and falls under this article's exemption.

Therefore, no MSDS is required.
