

Be sure to check all packing material carefully for small parts, which may have come loose inside the carton during shipment.

To prevent possible scratches and damage, this furniture must be assembled by two people on a soft surface such as a blanket or carpet.



8-Drawer Dresser





To remove the drawer if it ever becomes necessary:


- A. Pull the drawer fully open so the black latch is visible in the inside channel of the guides.
- B. Release the latches by simultaneously pushing one lever up and the other down.
- C. At the same time, pulling the drawer forward until the slides release.
- To reinstall the drawers, carefully align the channels of the guide and push drawer back into Dresser. Open and close drawer fully a couple times to verify proper operation.

Step 1. Install the Leveler (B) into the bottom end of the Center Support Leg (A), if not pre-installed. Attach the Support Leg to the bottom of the Dresser as shown.

The Levelers in the Center Support Leg and underneath the Bottom Corners can be adjusted to provide support for the middle of the Dresser and compensate for uneven flooring if necessary.

Anti-Tip Hardware Installation Instructions

Notice: We recommends that steps be taken for certain furniture items to prevent or minimize the risk of tip-over. This furniture is equipped with Tip-over RestraintHardware for use to minimize this risk, if used. Please follow below installation steps. - 1. Temporarily locate the furniture to near it's final location in the room next to a wall. Locate a wall stud behind your furniture and also mark the stud's location on the back of your furniture.
- 2. Firmly attach one bracket to the stud approximately 2" below the top of the furniture with the 2 inch long Wood Screws provided. It may be necessary to drill 3/32 dia. pilot holes for the screws.
- 3. Firmly attach the other bracket onto a solid, structural part on the back of the furniture using the <u>5/8 inch long</u> Wood Screws. It may also be necessary to pilot bore for these screws.
- 4. Move the furniture into its final position, taking care to line up the wall bracket with the furniture bracket. Thread a strap through the bracket as shown in the illustration. Tighten strap until snug but do not over tighten.

Warning: This tip-over restraint is not to be a substitute for proper adult supervision. Do not allow children to climb on furniture. Items left on top of the TV and furniture, such as toys, remote controls and treats might tempt young children to climb. Push the TV as far back as possible from the front of its stand. Place electrical cords out of a child's reach, and teach children not to play with the cords.
