CAUTION: To prevent electrical shock, ensure electricity has been turned off at the circuit breaker before beginning.

- Read all instructions before installing.
- System is intended for installation by a licensed electrician in accordance with the National Electrical Code (NEC) and local regulations.
- When handling the fixture, do not apply pressure to the LEDs. Hold the fixture by the base only.
- Retain installation instructions for future maintenance reference.

WARNING: All parts must be used as indicated in these instructions. This product is designed for use only with the supplied parts and/or accessories designated for use by dweLED. Substitution of parts or accessories not designated for use with this product by dweLED could result in personal injury or property damage, and will void the warranty. Contact an authorized dealer or the manufacturer if any parts are damaged or missing.

MAINTENANCE NOTE: Coastal conditions may cause mineral and residue build-up on the fixture. We recommend that customers in coastal areas clean all external surfaces of the fixture once every two weeks with a wet cloth.

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION

## PREPARATION

1. Shut off the power at the circuit breaker and remove existing fixture, including the crossbar.
2. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts on a clear area. Be careful not to lose any small parts necessary for installation.

## MOUNTING THE FIXTURE

3. There are three parts for the lamp body when unpacking the package as shown below (Fig. 1).

Part 3
4. Hold Part 1 with the "guiding hole" facing toward you with long extended ends pointing down. Rotate arms as shown below to get the diagram on the right (Fig. 2) .
a) Rotate $180^{\circ}$ clockwise on arm A
b) Rotate $90^{\circ}$ clockwise on arm B
c) Rotate $90^{\circ}$ anti-clockwise on arm C

5. For Part 2, rotate the arm by $45^{\circ}$ with respect to the guiding hole as shown to reveal the mounting holes. Connect the wire connector with Part 1 . Secure the parts with the assembly screw(C) , then rotate the arm back to cover the holes as shown (Fig. 3) .

6. For Part 3, rotate the arm by $45^{\circ}$ with respect to the guiding hole as shown to reveal the mounting holes. Connect the wire connector with Part 1. Secure the parts with the assembly screw(C), then rotate the arm to cover the holes as shown (Fig. 4).
Note : All the six lamp arms can be adjustabed after installation. You can adjust the arms of the fixture to desire position with the angle of rotation not exceeding 30 degree.

7. Remove the mounting screw (B) from the fixture. Choose number of rod suitable of your application. Thread the fixture wire through the rod, swivel and canopy. Connect the canopy, swivel, rod and fixture body. Make sure all are tightened (Fig. 5).

8. Secure the mounting back plate to the junction box using standard junction box screws that comes with the junction box.

Note: (i) Using any other non-original-manufacturer provided junction box screw may result in safety issue;
(ii) The side of the mounting plate marked "GND" must face out.

## CONNECTING THE WIRES

9. Cut the excessive wire which needs to be tucked back into the canopy (due to the limit room within the canopy) if necessary. Connect the driver's in put wires to junction box wires as shown (Fig. 6). Make sure that all wire connectors (A) are secured. If your outlet box has a green or bare copper ground wire, connect the fixture's ground wire to it. Otherwise, connect the fixture's ground wire directly to the back plate using the green screw provided. After wires are connected, tuck them carefully inside the junction box.

## COMPLETING THE INSTALLATION

10. Secure the fixture to the mounting back plate using the mounting screw (B) as shown (Fig. 5) .
11. For slope ceiling application, rotate swivel at the top of the stem to ensure luminarie is aiming down (Fig.8).

## DIMMING WIRING INFORMATION

12. This fixture features electronic low voltage (ELV or TRAIC) dimming capabilities. See notes below for specific dimming wires information (Fig. 7) .
13. To utilize ELV or TRAIC dimming: use wires black (hot), white (neutral) and bare copper ground wire (ground) .
14. To utilize $0-10 \mathrm{~V}$ dimming: use wire purple (dim+), gray (dim-), black (hot), white (neutral) and bare copper ground wire (ground) . NOTE : Make sure to connect 0-10V prior to power-up the fixture in order to allow the $0-10 \mathrm{~V}$ dimming to function properly .
