


Do not overtighten screws. (Insert all screws before tighten screws)

- 8. This is made with UV-stabilizers to minimize fading, however, upon exposure to the sun, all colors will fade to some degree. To minimize possible fading: keep product covered, utilize cushions where applicable, minimize direct sunlight by storing product when not in use, or use a UV-protectant.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Avoid harsh, abrasive cleaners, and other corrosive chemicals.
- Do not use metal scouring pad for cleaning. Most stains can be removed by using a mild soap and a soft-bristled brush.
- Avoid placing any direct heat source on or near the surface.
- Leaving any glassware on Chair under sunlight may result in burn marks on the surface. Please use a coaster when placing glassware on Chair.
