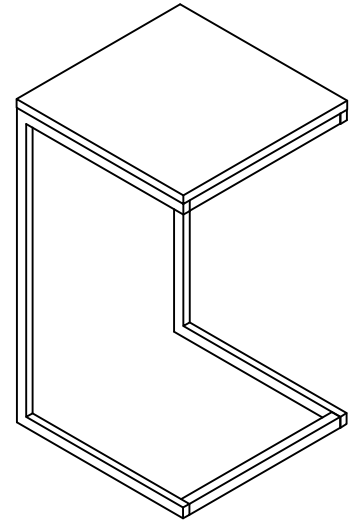

ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

1. Remove all packaging materials, staples and packing straps from the carton.
2. Refer to Parts List and Hardware List, and ensure parts and hardware are complete before assembly.
Contact customer service for missing parts.
3. Place all wooden parts on a clean, flat and soft surface (e.g. carpet or rug) to prevent parts from getting scratched.

SAFETY PRECAUTION

1. KEEP ALL HARDWARE PARTS OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
2. DISPOSE PLASTIC PACKAGING MATERIAL IMMEDIATELY TO AVOID ANY RISK OF SUFFOCATION TO CHILDREN AND ANIMALS.

TIPS FOR ASSEMBLY

1. Allow ample room for assembly and in close proximity to where product will be placed.
2. Assemble the product on a surface that does not scratch or damage the exterior gloss and finish of the furniture.
3. Identify all of the parts, hardware and quantities required for each step.
4. During assembly, do not over-tighten any fittings as this may cause damage.
5. DO NOT USE POWER TOOLS TO ASSEMBLE THIS PRODUCT.
6. Always place the product on a flat level surface.
7. Do not sit or stand on the partially assembled product; only use the product for which it is intended.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE








- Use a slightly damp cloth to clean the product. Do not use bleach or abrasive cleaning material.
- Check all the fittings periodically and re-tighten as necessary. Do not use the product if any of the parts is damaged or broken.
- Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture. Absorption can cause wood to warp or delaminate.
- Do not place hot items (e.g. hot drinks) directly onto the wood surface.
- Do not drag and/or pull the furniture.

This product is for indoor and household use only - not for commercial use.

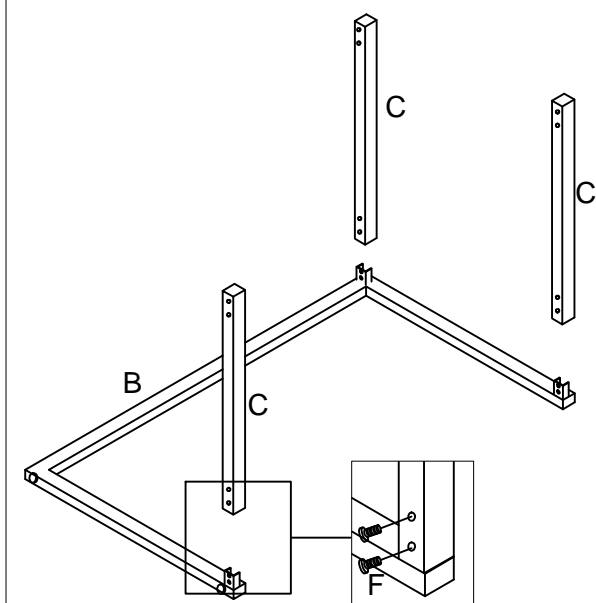

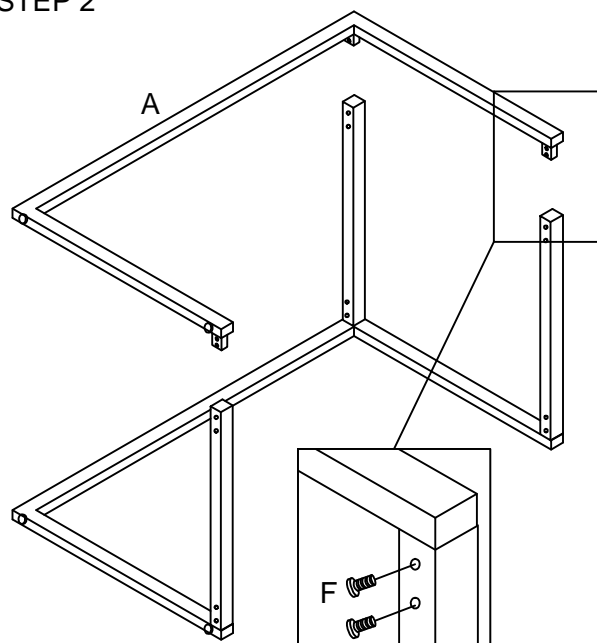

STEP 1



- Lay Leg (B) flat as shown on a material that does not scratch or damage the part.
- Insert and fit Connecting Bar (C) into the bracket on (B) and align the screw holes on each part.
- Fasten (C) to the bracket on (B) with Bolt (F). Use Allen Wrench (G) to drive Bolt (F). Do not tighten the bolts completely until both bolts are in place on each Connecting Bar.

STEP 2

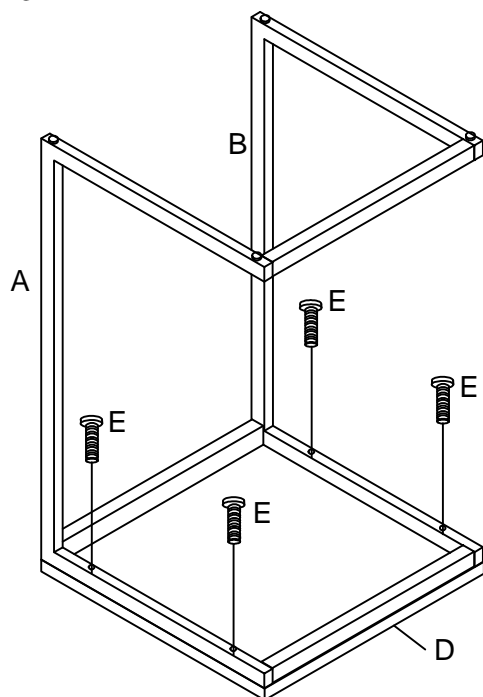


- Attach Leg (A) to Connecting Bar (C) by fitting the brackets on (A) onto each Connecting Bar (C), respectively.
- Fasten (A) to (C) with Bolt (F). Use Allen Wrench (G) to drive Bolt (F). Do not tighten the bolts completely until both bolts are in place on each Connecting Bar.

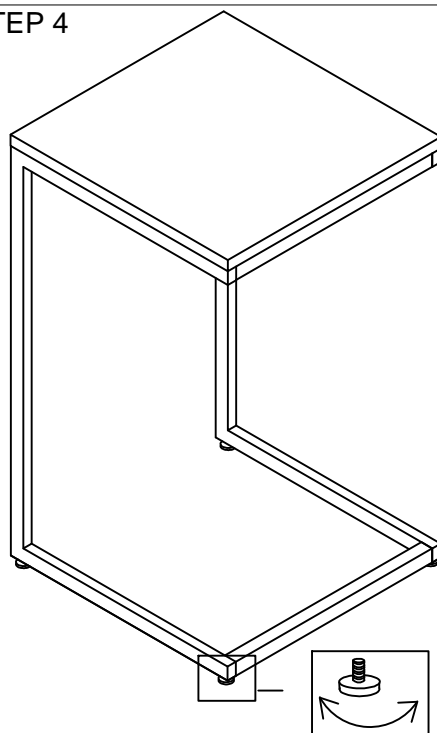

STEP 3



- Lay Top Panel (D) bottom-side as shown on a material that does not scratch or damage the part.
- Position the assembly from STEP 2 over (D) to align the table frame squarely to (D).
- Fasten (D) to the table frame with Bolt (E). Use Allen Wrench (G) to drive Bolt (E). Do not tighten the bolts completely until all four bolts are in place.

STEP 4



- Place the table right-side up.
- Adjust threaded Leg Stud to level the legs as needed.

The assembly of the table is complete.
