

Prior to Installation:

- Make sure you have all necessary parts by checking the diagram and parts list. If any part is missing or damaged, please contact Kraus Customer Service at 800-775-0703 for a replacement.
- Turn off the cold and hot water at the angle stops and turn on the old faucet to release and built up pressure
- Flush angle stops to release any debris prior to installation
- Pre-drilled hole size requirement: 1 3/8" (min) 1 1/2" (max)
- Max countertop thickness: 1 3/4"






NOTE: Specialized tools may be necessary to install Kraus Stainless Steel Kitchen sinks with countertop materials other than wood, marble or granite.



Topmount Installation


Step 1. Position Template



- Check the cut-out template against the actual sink to ensure a proper sized cut-out.
- Place the cut-out template in the desired location on the countertop.

NOTE: Make sure clearance is suitable for backsplash, faucet and plumbing for the sink.

Step 2. Trace Template





Trace template on countertop with a pencil.

Step 3. Cut Countertop

• Cut the opening in the countertop by carefully following the traced line.


NOTE: Please use the appropriate saw that best fits your countertop material.






Step 4. Attach Mounting Hardware

- Attach mounting hardware to the prongs protruding from the underside of the sink rim.
- Make sure the hooked side of the mounting clip is facing away from the sink.




Step 5. Apply Silicone or Plumber's Putty

- Clean and dry the surface around the opening of the sink.
- Turn the unit upside down to apply sealant. Apply silicone-based sealant (not included) underneath the edge of the sink.




Step 6. Secure Sink to Countertop

- Insert the sink into the opening, check the alignment of the sink to the cutout in the countertop and press firmly.
- Tighten the screws in the front of the sink, followed by the ones in the back and on the sides of the sink. Remove excess silicone-based sealant.
- Allow sealant to set for 30-60 minutes.



Step 7. Install Plumbing Fixtures


- Connect drain to sink. Connect trap to drain. Connect water supply connections to faucet according to manufacturer's instructions
- Run water into sink and check for leaks.




Undermount Installation

Step 1. Determine reveal type

 Use scissors to cut along the line of the paper template for your desired reveal type (Negative, Positive, or Flush Reveal)




Step 2. Position template



- Check the cut-out template against the actual sink to ensure a proper sized cut-out.
- Place the cut-out template in the desired location on the countertop.


NOTE: Make sure clearance is suitable for backsplash, faucet and plumbing for the sink.

Step 3. Trace Template




• Trace template on countertop with a pencil.

Step 4. Cut countertop




• Cut the opening in the countertop by carefully following the traced line.

NOTE: Please use the appropriate saw that best fits your countertop material.




Step 5. Set up mounting brackets




- Turn countertop over and align sink with countertop. Decide location for mounting brackets.
- Mounting holes should be 1/2" from edge of sink.

Step 6. Drill hole in countertop

• Drill 3/8" diameter x 1/2" deep hole in the countertop.




Step 7. Install anchors




• Insert anchors into drilled holes and lightly tap with a hammer until flush.

Step 8. Secure sink to countertop



 Use a bead of silicone (or preferred adhesive) around the rim of the sink. Check the alignment of the sink to the cutout in the countertop. Place sink over cutout hole and press firmly.

Step 9. Attach mounting hardware




- Attach mounting hardware to secure bowl. Remove excess sealant from inside lip.
- Allow sealant to set for 30 60 minutes.

NOTE: Use acetone or rubbing alcohol to remove any excess sealant.

Step 10. Install plumbing fixtures

- Connect drain to sink. Connect trap to drain. Connect water supply connections to faucet according to manufacturer's instructions.
- Run water into sink and check for leaks.




Maintenance

Clean your sink on a regular basis with warm soapy water. Rinse the sink after using cleaning products. Wipe the sink surface with a soft cloth to remove any liquid residue. Do not cut food directly on the surface of the sink. Do not leave sharp objects on the surface of the sink for an extended period of time. Do not use abrasive cleaning products, sanding tools, steel wool or bleaching products.




Faucet Installation Procedure



Installer Tip


Shut off main water supply before installing new faucet

1. Remove mounting hardware




 Remove the mounting screws (3D), mounting nut (3C), metal (3B) and rubber washer (3A) from the mounting pipe.

2. Install faucet mounting hardware




• Insert faucet body (2) into hole in countertop. Install mounting hardware (3A, B, C & D) from underneath the countertop.

3. Secure mounting hardware




• Adjust direction of faucet body (2) so that the handle is on the right side of the faucet. Tighten mounting nut (3C) until snug. Tighten mounting screws (3D) with Phillips screwdriver until snug.

4. Attach spray hose and counterweight




• Connect spray hose (6) to supply hose (4). Install weight (8) on lowest vertical point on spray hose (6).

5. Connect waterlines



 Connect waterlines (5A&B) to angle stops. Tighten both ends of waterlines with a wrench until snug. Turn on hot and cold angle stops and check for leaks.


6. Flush spray hose



Remove spray head (1) from spray hose (6). Hold tip of spray hose
 (6). Turn faucet on and let the water run for 60 seconds to flush any debris.


NOTE: Please make sure washer (7) is installed attaching spray head to hose

7. Check for leaks



• Check for leaks at the connections. Retighten if necessary.

Trouble-Shooting

If you have followed the instructions carefully and your faucet still does not work properly, take the following corrective steps:

PROBLEM	CAUSE	ACTION
Leakage under faucet handle	Locking nut has come loose or cartridge needs to be reseated	Remove button located at top of handle. Loosen set screw with hex wrench. Remove handle and unscrew cartridge cover by hand. Tighten locking nut with an adjustable wrench
Water does not shut off completely	Cartridge may need to be adjusted or replaced	Remove button located at top of handle. Loosen set screw with hex wrench. Remove handle and unscrew cartridge cover by hand. Unscrew locking nut with an adjustable wrench. Remove ceramic disc cartridge. Check for cracks and if O-ring is seated correctly. Reseat cartridge
Leaking between spray head and the hose	Spray head may be loose or washer is not seated correctly in the hose connection	Tighten spray head by hand until snug. Make sure washer is seated correctly
Hose does not retract	Weight may be installed incorrectly	Readjust weight on hose
Low flow	Aerator may be clogged	Unscrew aerator with aerator key. Hold tip of spray head and turn on water to flush debris
	Waterlines may be clogged	Turn off the water supply at water valve and unscrew the hose connectors from water supply lines. Clean the screen in the water lines with hot water, removing any debris or calcium build up.

Kraus warrants the structure and finish of the product to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal usage for the lifetime of the product. The warranty commences from the initial date of purchase by the owner or trade professional, from an authorized Kraus dealer, through the lifetime of the original owner or end-user.

Any product reported to the authorized dealer or to Kraus as being defective within the warranty period will be repaired or replaced with a product of equal value at the option of Kraus. This warranty extends to the original owner or end-user, and is not transferable to a subsequent owner.

Restrictions

This warranty does not cover antediluvian, discontinued, or display products, whether such items are purchased at discount outlets, unauthorized dealers, and/or sold on clearance.
