
ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

NOTES: 1. Before installing, consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirements.

2. READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS.



- 3. Pull out the source wires from the outlet box. Make wire connections using wire nuts as follows:
 - ---Connect the hot wire (usually black insulation) from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.
 - ---Connect the neutral wire (usually white insulation) from the fixture to the white wire from the power source.
 - ---Attach the fixture grounding wire (usually green insulation or bare wire) to the cross bar with the green grounding screw, and then connect it to the house grounding wire with the wire nut.

Carefully put the wires back into the outlet box.

- 4. Attach the fixture body to the cross bar by inserting headless screws into holes on back plate, and then secure it with two rubber pads and two ball nuts.
 - NOTE: With silicone caulking compound, caulk completely around where the back plate meets with the wall surface to prevent water from seeping into the outlet box.
- 5. Install a bulb (not included). Check relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum allowed wattage.

Turn on the power at fuse or circuit box
