

ASSEMBLY TIPS

- 1. Find a clean, level surface to begin the assembly of your game table. We recommend that two adults work together to assemble this game. You may want to carefully cut or tear the four corners of the box so that the bottom of the box can be used as your work surface.
- 2. Remove all of the contents from box and verify that you have all of the parts shown on the Parts Identifier before you begin assembly. **Note: Some parts may be pre-installed or pre-assembled.**
- 3. Some figures or drawings may not look exactly like your product. Please read and understand the text before beginning each assembly step.
- 4. When installing parts that have more than one screw or bolt, hand tighten all screws or bolts in place before final tightening with screwdriver or wrench.
- 5. Electric screwdrivers may be helpful during assembly; however, please set a *low torque* and use extreme caution because screws may be stripped or overtightened, resulting in damaged parts, if the electric screwdriver's torque is set too high.





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Attach LEGS #2 to the underside of the TABLE BODY #1 as shown with 2-1/4" BOLT #5 and FLAT WASHER #6. *Note: The door opening must face outwards.*
- 2. Attach two LEG LEVELERS #4 to each LEG as shown.



- 3. Carefully turn table over. Attach MANUAL SCORERS #8 to TABLE BODY as shown with 1-1/2" SCREW #9. Use the playing field "3" line as a guide to align the end of the MANUAL SCORERS, as shown, for placement. Cover each SCREW with one SCREW CAP #10.
- 4. Attach DOOR HANDLE #12 to door opening on LEG.


CARE AND USE

- 1. This product is intended for INDOOR use only.
- 2. Do NOT sit, climb or lean on the table.
- 3. Do NOT drag the table when moving it as this will damage the legs.
- 4. This Shuffleboard is equipped with Climatic Adjusters underneath the table to level the playfield. Because of humid weather or dry conditions, it is occasionally necessary to make adjustments in order to keep the playfield true. Make sure your table is level in both directions using Leg Levelers before making any adjustments using the Climatic Adjusters.


If necessary, begin the adjustment process by placing a straight edge across the playfield directly above the first Climatic Adjuster at either end of the table. This will determine if the playfield is concave or convex. The shuffleboard surface should be slightly concave to prevent the pucks from falling off the sides of the board.

Each Climatic Adjuster consists of three anchor bolts attached to the underside of the playfield through a metal bar. Adjustments will be made to the center bolt only. The outer two bolts are used to hold the metal bar in place.

To correct a convex playfield, loosen the nut above the metal bar. Slowly tighten the nut below the metal bar up against the bar in order to pull the center of the playfield down.



To correct a concave playfield, loosen the nut below the metal bar. Slowly tighten the nut above the metal bar down against the bar in order to push the center of the playfield up.



Important: nuts should be tightened slowly with 1/4 to 3/4 turns at a time. It may take a few days for the shuffleboard to completely react. DO NOT over tighten, as this can cause permanent damage to the Climatic Adjusters and your table.

Once the desired adjustment has been made, continue to the next Climatic Adjuster and repeat the process.

Please note that the shuffleboard will react to the adjustments for several days. Check the playfield again after a few days to determine if further adjustments are needed.
